Ribbon Cutting Ceremony set for SH 130, Opening from Highway 79 to North of Georgetown

- When:** December 13, 2006. Ceremonies begin at 10 a.m. (allow time for parking)
- What:** State and local leaders will cut the ribbon for State Highway 130, Segment One of the Central Texas Turnpike Project, one of the largest active highway construction projects in the nation. More than 13 miles of new roadway from north of Georgetown – at the intersection of I-35 and SH 195 – to US 79 will open December 13th. With the addition of this new portion, drivers will now be able to travel along SH 130 from US 290 east of Austin to north of Georgetown without traffic signals – a total of almost 30 miles. SH 130 near Georgetown will provide alternative driving routes and ease congestion for drivers already using the Loop 1 Extension, SH 45, and SH 130 (from Hwy 79 to 290)
- Where:** The ribbon cutting will be at the interchange of I-35 and SH 130. A map with driving instructions is also included. To arrange media access to SH 130 or any other location on the toll road, please contact Gabriela Garcia at 512-475-2134.
